

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Database License

CSA hereby grants Customer a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to obtain access to the Databases and all updates thereto listed on the Registration Form via CSA Illumina in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein and on the Supplement attached hereto. Customer may use the Databases for search and retrieval purposes in the internal operation of its organization only or, if Customer is an individual, for his personal use only. Customer may also print and download selected records for research and scholarly purposes. This license is a site license, which allows for access by a single entity (school, business, or public agency) located either in a single building or in a cluster of related buildings situated within a compact geographic area such as a single campus, a company main headquarters facility or a public agency's central office. The Databases may be networked throughout the geographic area and may also be made available remotely through secure access procedures that Customer establishes. If Customer is an academic institution, then this license extends to Customer's Authorized Users. Authorized Users are faculty, staff, students and walk-in patrons of its libraries.

The Databases may also be used for purposes of research or education, as follows:

Display. Customer and Authorized Users shall have the right to electronically display the Databases.

Digitally Copy. Customer and Authorized Users may download and digitally copy a reasonable portion of the Databases.

Print Copy. Customer and Authorized Users may print a reasonable portion of the Databases.

Recover Copying Costs. Customer may charge a reasonable fee to Authorized Users in order to cover the costs of copying or printing portions of Databases for Authorized Users.

Course Packs. Customer and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Databases in the preparation of Course Packs or other educational materials.

Electronic Reserve. Customer and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Databases for use in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by Customer.

Analysis. 2. MultiSearch License

CSA hereby grants Customer a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to obtain access to

MultiSearch, a federated search solution powered by CSA Illumina. This license is a site license, which allows for access by a single entity (school, business, or public agency) located either in a single building or in a cluster of related buildings situated within a compact geographic area such as a single campus, a company main headquarters facility or a public agency's central office. If Customer is an academic institution, then this license extends to Customer's Authorized Users. Authorized Users are faculty, staff, students and walk-in patrons of its libraries.

MultiSearch may be networked throughout the geographic area and may also be made available remotely through secure access procedures that Customer establishes. Customer must ensure that any link that it establishes in order for its Authorized Users to access MultiSearch is secure and for Authorized Users only.

Use of MultiSearch is subject to the terms and conditions herein as well as any terms and conditions that may be imposed by the individual electronic resources other than CSA (including databases) accessed via MultiSearch. Customers will need to provide accurate and complete authorization and authentication information for all electronic resources accessed via MultiSearch.

3. Payment

Customer must pay the appropriate subscription fees plus all applicable sales, use or similar taxes for use of the Databases and/or MultiSearch. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Customer may elect, if Customer so chooses, to have a limited trial period of the Databases and/or MultiSearch. At the end of the trial, Customer must pay the appropriate fees to retain the right to use the Databases and/or MultiSearch. If the fees are specified in dollars, then they are to be paid in United States dollars.

4. Proprietary Rights in the Databases and MultiSearch

8. **System Requirements**

Customer acknowledges that there are certain system requirements that are necessary in order to use CSA Illumina and MultiSearch and Customer is financially and technically responsible for ensuring that these requirements are met. These system requirements are (a) full access to the Internet (TCPIP) and (b) a World Wide Web browser, either Netscape (version 6.0 or higher) or Microsoft Internet Explorer (Version 5.0 or higher). Other suitable browsers should include support for HTML 4.0, XHTML 1.0, and CSS 1 (Cascading Style-sheets). Use of the Administrative Profile Module requires support for Javascript 1.5. CSA recommends using the most current browsers available.

9. **Force Majeure**

CSA shall not be responsible for any failure to perform, or delay in performance, in whole or in part, due to unforeseen circumstances or circumstances beyond CSA's control.

10. **Term and Termination**

CSA may cancel the Database License or the MultiSearch License if Customer violates any of the terms and conditions set forth herein or in the Supplement. At the end of the Database License period (so long as CSA has not terminated the Database License due to Customer's violation of any terms and conditions), and upon Customer's written request (which must be made within 30 days of the end of the license period), (i) CSA shall deliver to Customer for its use the material added to the CSA proprietary Databases to which Customer subscribed during the period that Customer's subscription was in effect, and (ii) CSA will make available, for an additional fee, the backfiles to the proprietary Databases to which Customer subscribed. All information will be delivered in a documented format, at CSA's absolute discretion, for local loading at Customer's institution or at a CSA-approved site and on a CSA-approved system. Customer may at its option pay CSA an annual fee to access the information via CSA Illumina. This prohibition does not limit use by patrons while in the public library.
